

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Whitton View has a phone to ring the Stables and for emergency calls.
- There is no public transport to or from Conifer Cottage. There is car parking at the back of the cottage.
- All beds come with duvets and all bedding is provided at no extra cost. Whitton also provides towels.
- Bookings run from 3.00 p.m. Saturday to 10.00 a.m. Saturday and the key can be collected from the cottage opposite the stables.
- Terms: a 50% deposit is payable on booking. The balance is due two weeks before arrival and electricity charges are payable on the day of departure at a rate of 12p per unit. Cheques payable to Mr Jeffreys.
- Please note we do not take credit cards.
- Weekend breaks are available at the bargain rate of £70 per night per 4 persons. An extra charge of £10 may be incurred for extra persons to cover costs this is just for short breaks.
- Milk groceries and newspapers are available from Milfield open 7 days a week. There is a supermarket at Berwick 14 miles away or some very good shops in Wooler 7 miles away.
- The water supply at Conifer is from a private spring.

## RESTAURANTS, HOTELS, PUBS

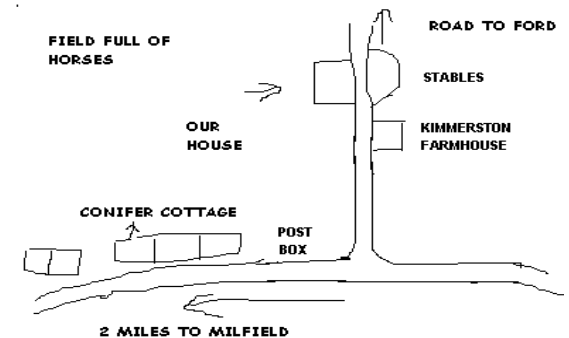

## FISHING

Good local, inexpensive fishing (within walking distance) on the River Till is always available and Salmon fishing on the famous waters of the Tweed, or any of its tributaries, can be arranged.

## GOLF

Bamburgh Castle Golf Course, described by the AA as one of the most beautiful courses in Britain, takes visitors all year round. There is also Doddington golf course only three miles away where it is as if you are on top of the world! There are also several others golf courses in the area.

## SIGHTSEEING

Ford Castle is a fifteen minutes walk and Holy Island is some 15 miles from Kimmerston. The very spectacular Bamburgh Castle is a twenty-minute drive, as is Seahouses Harbour from where boat trips around the Farne Islands bird sanctuary depart. There are many more unique castles and houses which includes. Alnwick Castle the home of the Percy family since the 15th century, including the now famous Millennium gardens created recently by the Percy family in conjunction with other nationally acclaimed horticulturists.

## RIDING

Most of the holiday guests take advantage of the **British Horse Society approved** Kimmerston Riding Centre at least once during their stay. The Centre has horses and ponies of different sizes and for people of all ages and levels of expertise. Rides and lessons are organised daily at the convenience of the guests, who are given the opportunity to choose between quiet country lanes, moor lands, hill rides, brideways, or take the short trip to the beach to gallop along Holy Island's white sands.
