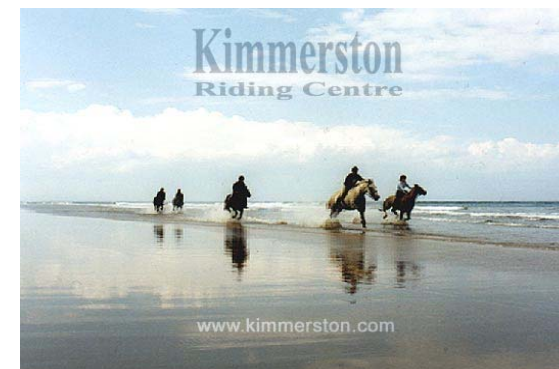

HOW TO FIND US!

Set in the midst of dramatic scenery at the foot of the Cheviot Hills, surrounded by the most beautiful riding country, we are equidistant from Edinburgh and Newcastle and 8 miles from the coast. Bamburgh Castle and the Farne Islands are also nearby. Our nearest train station is Berwick-upon-Tweed (14m), from which we can arrange collection. There is local fishing on the farm, a small golf course 4 miles away and many spectacular walks nearby.



THE HORSES AND RIDING

We cater for riders of all ages and abilities, including the disabled. We make every effort to match horses and riders according to experience and ability so that everyone will have fun and take away happy memories of the best riding country in England. Your safety as well as your enjoyment is our priority.

We have 30 quality horses and ponies, ranging from Josh at over 17hh to Barney Rubble at 9hh. All rides are escorted by members of staff to ensure that families of mixed abilities can enjoy rides together. For the experienced, our horses are forward going ... many riders are surprised by their willingness.

WHAT WE HAVE TO OFFER

INSTRUCTIONAL RIDES - For beginners, or for those who are a little rusty. This is a much more enjoyable way for you to learn and we believe it also makes for a happier horse.

1 HOUR RIDE - Meander along the banks of the Till, canter through the woods and see if you can spy the occasional red squirrel or roe deer.

2 HOUR MOOR RIDE - Enjoy the panoramic views, from the coast to the East to the Cheviots to the West, as you ride across bracken moors across streams and through woods. Interesting flora and fauna are to be seen throughout the year.

SPECIALITIES



BEACH RIDE - Travel to the famous Holy Island to ride across the sands and see the birds and seals, then gallop along the amazing expanse of beautiful beach and splash in the surf. For the 'brave', a bare-back swim in the bracing North Sea is always exhilarating! - as featured on National TV. The Beach ride is only for the experienced rider.

Please **NOTE** this!!!

HILL RIDE - a short trip takes you to the Cheviot Hills where we ride up to the top and see a never to be forgotten view, then gallop along the springy heather. Again only for the experienced rider.

GROUPS - we are very experienced at looking after groups of all sizes and regularly have large school outings, police cadets, cubs/scouts and office parties of up to 50. According to numbers we alternate riding with stable management instruction. Please ask about our discounted rates.

ACCOMMODATION

On the farm we have Conifer Cottage a self-contained cottage, which sleeps up to 6 people. It has 3 bedrooms a bathroom, kitchen and a sitting room with an open coal fire and has recently been refurbished. It has storage heaters and is very comfortable. We also have Whitton View Cottage 2 miles away next to the pub in Milfield Village. It has two bedrooms but one is a loft conversion with a very low ceiling and tricky staircase so not suitable for small children there are many local Hotels and Bed and Breakfasts within easy reach of us.

Riding Holidays - come and stay either here or locally and ride as much or as little as you like. Many people do a bit of everything and even do the beach ride twice. We will organise your weeks riding when you arrive but please book your first ride beforehand i.e. your Sunday ride.

Unaccompanied Teenagers - we take unaccompanied teenagers for fun-packed riding holidays. They stay on the farm and enjoy plenty of riding and mucking in and out!
