Our aim is to improve your riding skills and knowledge, whilst having a good time. We encourage you to help care for the horses and ponies as well as ride. Lessons are available. However, we tend to put the emphasis on hacking out, as most people seldom get the opportunity to learn and ride in such fantastic countryside.



What to wear:

Hats - A hard hat to the current BSI standard (PAS 015 or BS EN 1384) is required - no exceptions! We can loan hats for those who do not have their own.

Riding boots: Or Jodhpur boots that have a small heel and nothing that could catch on a stirrup. Look for something strong enough to protect your feet with a *small* heel. Trainers are *not* suitable. **Trousers**- Anything loose and/or stretchy, such as leggings or joggers. Jeans don't usually work well - the thick inside seam tends to rub uncomfortably. **Body Protectors** - Kimmerston strongly encourages all of its regular riders to invest in a body protector, especially children and anyone wanting to jump. These are not a compulsory item of riding wear, but can significantly reduce the risk of injury in a fall.

We can cater for every rider, from the complete beginner to the most accomplished. We have a wide range of horses and ponies from Poo Bear at 12hh to Danny at 17hh. We offer riding ranging from 4-5 hours a day, including our adventurous hill rides and beach rides.

All meals and close supervision are included. Evening entertainment could include games, videos, quizzes or the occasional trip to the cinema or swimming pool. A variety of hats and boots are available for use at the stables.

Holidays normally run from Sunday about 1.30pm to Saturday 12.30am giving you the opportunity to ride both days however we can adapt this to fit in with any requirements you may have. Please note there is an extra charge for an extra night

Weekly rates are £600. This is fully inclusive of riding, meals and accommodation. A deposit of 25% is payable on booking and the balance is payable two weeks before the start of the holiday. Please take out holiday insurance (as you would with any holiday) as the money is not refundable.
