It has 3 bedrooms a bathroom, kitchen and a sitting room with an open coal fire and has recently been refurbished. It has storage heaters and is very comfortable. We also have Akeld Cottage 3 miles away towards Wooler It has three bedrooms bathroom kitchen and large sitting room with french doors into a large fenced garden and central heating there are also many local Hotels and Bed and Breakfasts within easy reach of us.

HOW TO FIND US

Set in the midst of dramatic scenery at the foot of the Cheviot Hills, surrounded by the most beautiful riding country, we are equidistant from Edinburgh and Newcastle and 8 miles from the coast. Bamburgh Castle and the Farne Islands are also nearby. Our nearest train station is Berwick-upon-Tweed (14m), from which we can arrange collection. There is local fishing on the farm, a small golf course 4 miles away and many spectacular walks nearby.

INSTRUCTIONAL AND GENERAL RIDES

For the young or novice rider we offer a half hour lead rein ride. Or for beginners, or for those who are a little rusty you will go out into the countryside on a gentle hack. This is a much more enjoyable way for you to learn and we believe it also makes for a happier horse.

1 or 2 HOUR RIDE

Meander around our quiet fields and pathways with views towards the hills, canter through the woods and see if you can spy the occasional red squirrel or roe deer.

2 HOUR MOOR RIDE

Enjoy the panoramic views, from the coast to the East to the Cheviots to the West, as you ride across bracken moors across streams and through woods. Interesting flora and fauna are to be seen throughout the year.

FAMILY RIDES

We offer a good deal on family rides (2 adults and 2 children) on any of the above rides.

GROUPS

We are very experienced at looking after groups of all sizes and regularly have large school outings, police cadets, cubs/scouts and office parties of up to 50. According to numbers we alternate riding with stable management instruction. Please ask about our discounted rates.

EXCLUSIVE BEACH RIDE (Limited availability)

Travel to the famous Holy Island to ride across the sands and see the birds and seals, then gallop along the amazing expanse of beautiful beach and splash in the surf. The beach ride is only available mid May to the end of September and is also determined by the tide times.

PLEASE NOTE the Beach ride is only for the experienced rider, minimum 2 people, maximum 4.

OUR HORSES AND RIDING

We cater for riders of all ages and abilities, including the disabled. We make every effort to match horses and riders according to experience and ability so that everyone will have fun and take away happy memories of the best riding country in England.
